

    - BSL (~CHF 44,800).
    - EU Business (full-time MBA ~CHF39,750; part-time ~CHF38,850).
  - Industry-specialized:
    - HIM hospitality MBA (~CHF45k).
    - IMD (~CHF 97–125k) is top-tier leadership.
- Nationality benefits: Swiss residents may receive discounts (e.g., Glion, EU Business domestic rates).

#### Camps in Switzerland: Seasonal Overview

Switzerland hosts a wide variety of camps throughout the year that combine education, sports, languages, and adventure, making it a top destination for both Swiss and international students.

#### Summer Camps in Switzerland (June-August)

Summer is the most popular season for camps in Switzerland, with options ranging from academic enrichment to outdoor adventure.

### Spring Camps in Switzerland (March-April)

Spring camps are shorter and usually coincide with school holidays (e.g., Easter break). They are often focused on language immersion, sports, or exam preparation

#### **Common Themes:**

- Ski & Snowboard + Language Camps
- Easter Revision / Exam Prep Camps
- Creative Arts or Music Workshops
- Spring Boarding School Taster Programs

## Winter Camps in Switzerland (December-February)

• Winter camps usually coincide with the Christmas holidays or February ski breaks, and are highly sought-after for skiing, snowboarding, and winter sports, often combined with language learning.

## **Typical Winter Camp Activities:**

- Skiing and snowboarding (daily lessons or excursions)
- Language classes in the morning (French, English, German)
- Evening entertainment (theater, music, storytelling)
- Cultural excursions (Christmas markets, chocolate factory tours)
